

Kansas Territory Statutes 1857

Notary Fees

Fees of Notary Public and Commissioner.

For each certificate and seal, 75 cents

taking depositions or other writings, for each one hundred words, 15 cents

administering an oath, 10 cents

for each protest, 75 cents

each notice thereof, 85 cents

when required, for each one hundred words in recording or copying such protest, 15 cents

taking acknowledgment of deeds, mortgages, powers of attorney, or other written instruments, 50 cents

traveling, per mile, when required, 10 cents

affidavit on certificate, and seal, 50 cents

noting bill of exchange or note, 25 cents

marine and fire insurance protest, \$1.00;

for all other services, the same fees as are allowed justices of the peace for similar services.
